



PACKING LIST

Please do not bring any camping gear or cooking gear without consulting outfitter. This list is structured for backcountry unguided drop camp hunts so use your discretion for guided or non-wilderness trips.

DOCUMENTS (carried on your person)

Drivers License or government picture ID

Hunter Ed Card (if born in 1949 or after – NO EXCEPTIONS)

Green CDOW License/Tag, zip tie and ballpoint pen

EQUIPMENT

Rifle

Rifle pre-sighted 2”-3” high at 100 yds

40 rounds of same brand/grain ammo

Scope covers

Compact cleaning kit

Archery

Bow/quiver & 1 dozen arrows

Cylinder arrow case

Extra string, rest, and sights?

Bow tool kit

Muzzleloader

Muzzleloader sighted at 75 yds

Several pre-loaded speedloaders

Powerbelt Platinum bullets

Extra powder, primers or caps **

OTHER EQUIPMENT – Rifle/Archery/Muzzle (carried in daypack or on your person)

Daypack (big backpack not needed for horse/vehicle hunts)

Knife and sharpener

Binoculars

Rangefinder

Bone saw *

Water bottle (filtered bottles now available)

Batteries

Lighter/Matches **

GPS *

Small First-Aid kit

Rubber gloves

Parachute cord

Sat phone or InReach (1 per group) *

Walkie-talkie radios *

Game calls *

Headlamp

TP and/or baby wipes

Orange flagging *

QUIET CLOTHING (worn and/or in waterproof 3ft. SOFT duffel for pack-in hunts)

2 pair boots (one insulated/both waterproof)

3 long sleeve camo shirts

4 pair light socks

4 pair heavy socks

2 pair gloves (1 insulated/waterproof)

Baseball cap (blaze solid orange for gun hunts)

Stocking hat (blaze solid orange for gun hunts)

Gaiters (for snow)

Blaze solid orange vest (for gun hunts)

Belt or suspenders

3 camo pants (wool, fleece?)

2 pair long underwear

Several extra underwear

Light hunting jacket

Heavy hunting jacket

Camp slippers

Raingear

Facemask

TOILETRIES (in shave kit in duffel)

Comb

Toothbrush/paste

Small shampoo

Medications/Ibuprofen, Diamox

Extra contacts/glasses

Razor

Soap

Unscented deodorant

Towel and washcloth

Moleskin/surgical tape

OTHER

-10F Mummy sleeping bag in waterproof stuff sack (for tent camps)

Food, paper plates/bowls, paper goods (drop camps only) *

* - Not required on guided hunts

** - Banned by airlines and/or TSA. Must purchase in Colorado or ship to outfitter.
